The doctor will be responsible for providing high-quality primary healthcare services to patients, ensuring effective diagnosis, treatment, and follow-up care. The ideal candidate will be passionate about community health, especially in underserved areas, and committed to improving the well-being of our patients through ethical and evidence-based medical practices.

Main responsibilities (but not limited to):

- Provide general medical consultations, diagnoses, and treatments in line with national and clinic protocols.
- Manage acute and chronic illnesses across all age groups.

- Prescribe appropriate medications and educate patients on their use.
- Promote preventative care through screenings, immunisations, and patient education.
