Overview

This position is responsible for conducting ecological research, managing data collection, and contributing to scientific publications. The coordinator serves as a vital link between scientific objectives and volunteer engagement, helping to implement a collaborative and educational environment.

- Write detailed reports and scientific papers based on research conducted at Kanaan.
- Supervise and mentor volunteers, ensuring their wellbeing and active participation in research activities.
